

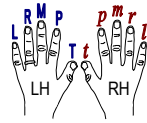

**Parallel Motion**  
Focus on the RH fingers. "Tell" the LH fingers to follow along. **P** & **p** play at the same times.

**Five Finger Position**  
In songs like Alouette whose notes fall within 5-key spans, you never have to shift hand positions, which reduces the likelihood of errors. Just keep your eyes on the music and press down the indicated fingers when you come to them.
